Samuel Tripp – Inquired about the STAR and Enhanced STAR program. Residents that qualify for the STAR program receive \$619. discount and the residents that qualify for the Enhanced STAR will received at \$1,294 discount. The STAR program is run by New York State.

Jennifer Cahill - What can happen if the budget is defeated? The present budget could be rolled over or the district could go to a Contingency Budget. If the district goes to a contingency budget, the district would have to go back to what we have now. No fringes would be allowed (ex. No equipment).

James Bell – What happens if the Library Proposition fails? Is the district liable? The district is not liable. But we will check into it further.


V. **ADJOURNMENT**
